

## **Results of 2023 Nationwide Case Review by Agency Against Corruption**

In 2023, Agency Against Corruption (AAC) continued to refer to issues of public concern, and requested the government ethics units of the competent authorities to conduct in-depth inventory of potential risks in the government affairs based on the risk assessment results of their respective agencies. Six major issues were selected: “government subsidies and private donations”, “green energy and major public constructions”, “public safety and public nuisance inspections”, “procurements in remote areas or agencies and schools without government ethics units”, “crucial livelihood-related or health and medical cases” and “high-risk commissioned projects” to carry out case reviews, prevent corruption and lawlessness via systematic investigations, and actively assist related agencies in establishing internal control and fraud prevention procedures, so as to fulfill the work value of the AAC in protecting public welfare.
